

Southampton Chess League 2010-11 Division 2 Analysis – Edward Davies 13/08/2011

Division Summary

Division 2 consisted of 6 teams in a 5 board double round robin of 10 rounds and 55 players participated. Southampton University A were clear winners with 8 match wins and 1 draw, followed by Winchester A with 5 wins and 2 draws, Passed Pawn B with 4 wins and 2 draws, Winchester College A with 3 wins and 3 draws, Southampton University B with 2 wins and 2 draws, and Ordnance Survey A with 1 win and 4 draws.

Team Summaries

(NB: the highest grading performances and percent scores are based on players who played 4 or more games.)

Southampton University A:

Matthew Lunn had a strong performance with the 2nd highest GP of 179.7, the 2nd highest points score of 7, and the 4th highest percentage score of 77.8%. Kamarunsalehin Kamis had the 4th highest GP of 177.2, the number one percentage score with 90%, and the 4th highest performance above a player's grade with +17.2. A. Ganesan had the 7th highest GP of 171.4. David Fowler had the 9th highest GP of 167.8, joint 3rd to 5th highest points score of 5.5, and the joint 7th to 8th highest percentage score of 68.8%. Ricky Vaja had the 9th highest percentage score of 62.5% and the number one performance above a player's grade with +45.5.

Winchester A:

Khalid Esmat had the 10th highest GP with 167.6. Mike White had the joint 3rd to 5th highest points score of 5.5, joint 7th to 8th highest percentage score of 68.8%, and 5th highest performance above a player's grade with +15.3. Robin Atkins had the 6th highest percentage score with 70%.

Passed Pawn B:

Stuart Dean had the 6th highest GP with 171.6, the 2nd highest percentage score of 80%, and the 2nd highest performance above a player's grade with +32.6. Kier Eyles had the joint 3rd to 5th highest points score of 5.5.

Winchester College A:

Patrick Butler had the 3rd highest GP of 178.8 and the 3rd highest percentage score of 80%. Ilya Iyengar had the 8th highest GP of 170.2.

Southampton University B:

Thomas McFaul had the 5th highest GP of 176.2 and Paul Johnson had the joint 6th to 7th highest points score of 5 and the 3rd highest performance above a player's grade with +18.

Ordnance Survey A:

Chris Jenks put in a very strong performance with the number one GP in the division of 197.1, the number one points score of 7.5, and the 5th highest percentage score of 75%. Philip Barber had the joint 6th to 7th highest points score of 5.
