

Southampton Chess League 2010-11 Division 4 Analysis – Edward Davies 13/08/2011

Division Summary

Division 4 consisted of 5 teams in a 4 board double round robin of 8 rounds, and 47 players participated. Salisbury C won the division with 6 match wins and a draw followed by Eastleigh Rail B with 4 wins and 2 draws, Southampton D with 3 wins and 2 draws, Winchester C with 2 wins and 2 draws, and Winchester College B with 1 win and 1 draw.

Team Summaries

(NB: the highest grading performances and percent scores are based on players who played 4 or more games.)

Salisbury C:

Mike Pope had an excellent performance with 5 wins and 2 draws, and had the number one GP in the division with 156, the number one points score of 6, the number one percentage score of 85.7%, and the 3rd highest performance above a player's grade with +30. Dick Wardell had the 2nd highest GP in the division with 133.8, the joint 4th to 5th highest percentage score with 75%, and the 4th highest performance above a player's grade with +27.8. Andrew Hopkins had the 4th highest GP with 127.5, joint 4th to 5th highest percentage score with 75%, and the number one performance above a player's grade with +58.5. Jim Barnett had the joint 7th to 8th highest points score of 3.5.

Eastleigh Rail B:

John Kooner had a strong performance with with 3rd highest GP of 131, joint 3rd to 6th highest points score of 4, joint 2nd to 3rd highest percentage score of 80%, and the 5th highest performance above a player's grade with +23. Sam Murphy had the 6th highest GP with 119.7, joint 3rd to 6th highest points score of 4, and joint 7th to 8th highest percentage score with 57.1%.

Southampton D:

David Murchie had the 5th highest GP with 123, joint 3rd to 6th highest points score of 4, joint 2nd to 3rd highest percentage score of 80%, and the 2nd highest performance above a player's grade with +32. John Davis had the 8th highest GP in the division with 117.6, the 2nd highest points score of 5, and the 6th highest percentage score with 62.5%. Dave Agostinelli had the 10th highest GP with 117.3 and the joint 7th to 8th highest points score of 3.5.

Winchester C:

Steve Kitley had the 7th highest GP of 119, the joint 3rd to 6th highest points score of 4, and the joint 7th to 8th highest percentage score of 57.1%. Jim Hough had the 9th highest GP with 117.5.
