

Southampton Chess League 2010-11 Division 5 Analysis – Edward Davies 13/08/2011

Division Summary

Division 1 consisted of 5 teams in a 4 board double round robin of 8 rounds, and 35 players participated. Southampton E came first with 7 wins followed by Southampton University D with 5 wins and 1 draw, Winchester D with 4 wins, Eastleigh Rail C with 3 wins, and Ordnance Survey C with 1 draw.

Team Summaries

(NB: the highest grading performances and percent scores are based on players who played 4 or more games.)

Southampton E:

J. Ingamells had the 5th highest GP with 103.1, joint 3rd to 7th highest points score with 5, joint 9th to 11th percentage score with 62.5%, and the 5th highest performance above a player's grade with +4.1. David Nelson was joint 1st to 2nd points scorer with 5.5 points, had the 7th highest GP with 97.4, and had the 8th highest percentage score with 68.8%. T. Hutchins had the 8th highest GP of 96.3, the 2nd highest percentage score with 87.5%, and the 3rd highest performance above a player's grade with +18.3.

Southampton University D:

Lee Neville had a very strong performance by winning 5 out of 5 games, with by far the highest GP in the division of 143.6, the number one percentage score of 100%, and joint 3rd to 7th points score of 5. Rob Hewitt put in a strong performance as well with the 2nd highest GP in the division of 113.7, joint 3rd to 7th highest points score of 5, joint 5th to 6th highest percentage score of 71.4%, and number one performance above a player's grade with +24.7. Dave Nguyen also had one of the best performances in the division with the 3rd highest GP of 106.3, joint 3rd to 7th highest points score of 5, and joint 5th to 6th highest percentage score of 71.4%. Josine Sahakian had the joint 9th to 11th highest percentage score of 62.5%.

Winchester D:

David Green had the joint 1st to 2nd highest points score of 5.5, 3rd highest percentage score of 78.6%, and the 9th highest GP with 94.7. Brian Jack had the 10th highest GP with 90.9. R. Collins had the 8th highest points score with 4.5 points.

Eastleigh Rail C:

John Kooner had the 4th highest GP in the division with 104.5 and the 4th highest percentage score with 75%. Nobby George had the 6th highest GP with 101.4, the 7th highest percentage score of 70%, and the 4th highest performance above a player's grade with +9.4.

Ordnance Survey C:

J. Goold had the joint 3rd to 7th highest points score of 5, joint 9th to 11th highest percentage score with 62.5%, and the 2nd highest performance above a player's own grade with +19.8.
