**RATE OF PLAY:** 40 moves in 100 minutes followed by a 20-minute quickplay finish.

**BYES:** A  $\frac{1}{2}$ -point bye may be taken in any one round except the last, if claimed in advance on the entry-form.

**TIES:** In the event of ties, prize money will be divided equally. Titles and trophies will be decided by the following tie-break system, in order of priority:

- 1. The result(s) between the players involved in the tie, provided they have all met
- 2. Sum of Progressive Scores
- 3. Sum of Opponents' Scores
- 4. Sonneborn-Berger Scores.

**ENTRY FEES:** The entry fees (Open £35.00, Major £30.00, Minor £27.00) are for current ECF Direct members at the Silver, Gold or Platinum levels. Non-members and Bronze level adult members must pay an additional 'Pay to Play' fee of £7.50.

#### NOTES:

- 1. Juniors (under 18) paying reduced fees must give their age on the 1st September 2018.
- 2. Ungraded players should give details of their recent results in the box below.
- 3. Entrants who are not members of the ECF or adults who are Bronze members must pay the 'Pay to Play' fee. Juniors should join the ECF for £5 before sending in the form.
- 4. Hampshire players must be affiliated to the Hampshire Chess Association either through their club or as an individual member. Hampshire Juniors may affiliate free of charge.
- 5. If paying by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) directly into the HCA bank account, a bank payment reference is required and must be on the entry form. This is "**18HIC-**" followed by up to 10 letters from the entrant's name, family name then given name.
- 6. This year the prize fund has been increased by 7%. The above prizes are guaranteed and are based on an entry of 25 players per event. If a larger entry is received, prizes may be increased or extra prizes may be awarded, including grading prizes. Any changes will be announced before the start of the third round.
- 7. The HCA Committee reserve the right to transfer a player to a different tournament or to refuse an entry without giving a reason.
- 8. A player who has not arrived 30 minutes after the start of a round will be defaulted, and his opponent will be re-paired, if possible.
- 9. It is a condition of entry that players agree to their names, games and grading information being published on the ECF and HCA websites.
- 10. We hope to have a second-hand bookstall on site on the Saturday and Sunday.
- 11. Please respect the wishes of the Hotel that only food and drink purchased from the Hotel is consumed on the Hotel premises.
- 12. Refreshments, all the tea and coffee you can drink, are charged by the hotel at £1 per person on Friday and £2 per person on Saturday and Sunday.
